To celebrate the 8th edition of Offprint Paris, from 9 – 12 November 2017, 130 independent publishers in art, photography and design, from 19 different countries, come together at the Beaux-Arts in Paris.

Created in 2010, Offprint is LUMA Foundation's platform supporting socially engaged editors experimenting new formats and contents. All year-round, Offprint gathers and presents a group of publishers and lesser-known publications, circulating mostly outside the traditional commercial networks: publishers *stricto sensu*, as well as art schools, magazines, self-published books, artists collectives, research reviews, zines...

Each year, Offprint organizes a series of events to support publishers: two fairs (Offprint Paris and Offprint London), several travelling libraries (Milan, Amsterdam), a permanent library at the Parc des Ateliers, in Arles, and curated bookshops for private and public institutions.

Supporting artists and the production of ground-breaking cultural projects, LUMA Arles is pleased to produce Offprint. LUMA Arles and Offprint both aim at supporting independent publishing and all fields of contemporary creation.

## ABOUT LUMA IN ARLES

In 2004, Maja Hoffmann created the LUMA Foundation to support the activities of artists, independent pioneers, and organizations working in the visual arts, photography, publishing, documentary film making, and other media.

The LUMA Foundation produces, supports, and enables challenging art projects committed to an expansive understanding of environmental issues, human rights, education, and culture.

In 2014, LUMA started the regeneration of the Parc des Ateliers, an expansive former industrial site located in Arles, France. Situated adjacent to the city's UNESCO World Heritage sites, the Parc des Ateliers serves as the major programmatic and cultural center for the LUMA Foundation's diverse activities.

The site includes a resource center designed by architect Frank Gehry (to open in 2019); various industrial buildings rehabilitated by Selldorf Architects; and a public park designed by landscape architect Bas Smets. Hoffmann works closely with the LUMA Arles Core Group (Tom Eccles, Liam Gillick, Hans Ulrich Obrist, Philippe Parreno, and Beatrix Ruf) on a program of exhibitions and multidisciplinary projects presented each year in the site's newly rehabilitated venues of the Grande Halle, Les Forges, and the Mécanique Générale.
